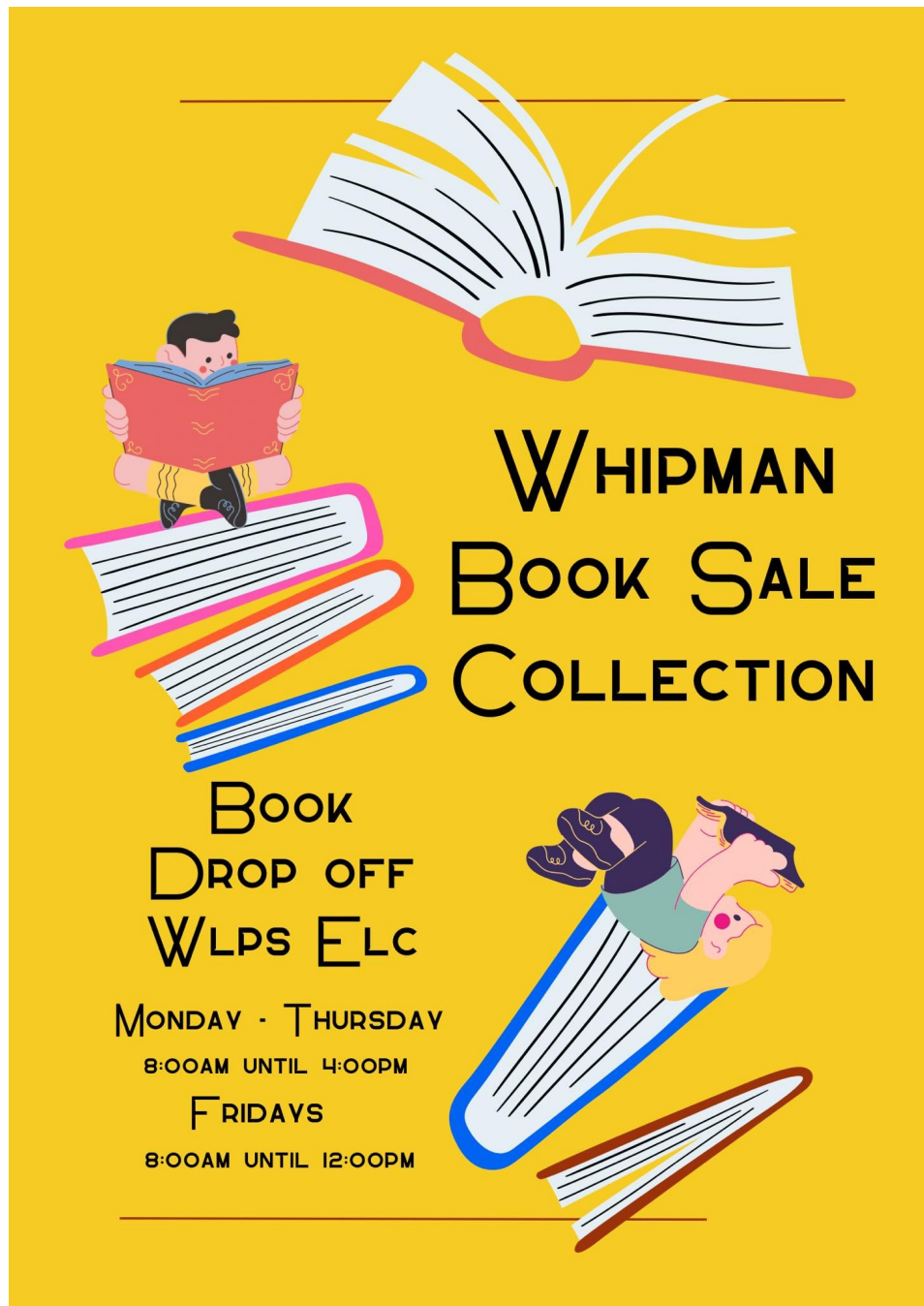

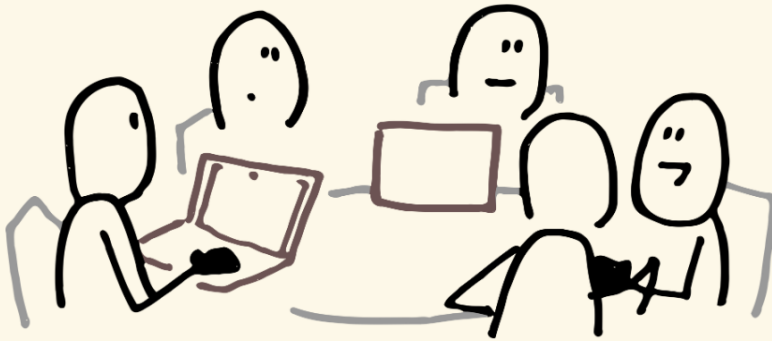
Wanderings is a reflective woodland wander; a gathering where all ages can reflect, talk and walk together.
