All articles on show not intended for sale must be clearly marked "Not for Sale" and owners of these exhibits are requested to remove them just before the sale.

Not more than one entry per exhibitor per class.

All exhibits are entered at the owners own risk. The committee will not accept responsibility in the event of loss or damage of any exhibits.
